

PASSIVE PARK PAVILION RENTAL POLICY

1. Reservations must be made 14 calendar days in advance of the day requested for rental.
2. The picnic shelter can be rented for one of two daily periods 11 AM to 3:00 PM and 4:00 PM until 8:00 PM, Monday through Sunday.
3. The cost for Hermantown residents and organizations is \$25 plus a \$75 dollar damage deposit. The cost for non-Hermantown residents and organizations is \$50, with a \$100 damage deposit.
4. No gas grills, charcoal grills or open fires are allowed inside the shelter. (Charcoal Grills are available on site.) All charcoal fires must be fully extinguished before leaving the site.
5. No vehicles are allowed inside the park. Special permission is required for loading, unloading, and handicap accessibility. Key is required (and must be returned).
6. No fireworks of any kind are allowed.
7. Alcohol is not allowed.
8. No loud speakers are allowed.
9. Refuse that does not fit in the containers provided must leave the site

Failure to comply with any of the above mentioned rules and regulations will result in the forfeiture of the security/damage deposit. Loss of the deposit will be at the discretion of Hermantown City Staff.
