State of Minnesota requirements to be an Election Judge:

- Must be a United States citizen, at least 18 years of age, and attend mandatory training.
- Must be eligible to vote in the State of Minnesota and be able to read, write, and speak English.
- Finished with all parts of a felony sentence, including probation or parole, in any state.
- Not under guardianship status in which a judge has removed your right to vote.
- Must not live, either permanently or temporarily, with any candidate on the ballot at that election or be a candidate in the election.

Requirements, Wages and Time Off from Work

- You must complete an election judge training course (at least two hours); you will be paid.
- The City of Hermantown will pay all judges using a W-4 (which we will collect at a later date).
- Election judges can choose to volunteer or be paid.
- Employers are <u>required to give employees time off to work</u> as an election judge. <u>Letter to employer</u>. More information available on the Minnesota Secretary of State website.

I understand giving false information or omitting requested data may disqualify me from further consideration as an election judge or result in dismissal, if discovered at a later date.
