Residents -

The City is set to begin the next phase of the Hermantown Road/Old Midway Road Improvement Project. This process - which has included everything from public meetings to the recent right of way clearing - will now start to feel much more like a construction project.

Regarding the right of way, it is important to remove any personal property - from vehicles to driveway decorations - from the areas where work will be performed. This will keep items from getting damaged during the road improvement efforts, which will range from full reconstruction to reclaim and overlay work, stormwater improvements, new driveway culvers, aprons and fire numbers, and more.

This project also features a rebuilding of the bridge on Hermantown Road near Five Corners Road. This work will necessitate the closing of that bridge beginning **Wednesday, May 8, at 6:00 a.m.** While the road itself will remain open to local traffic during the entire project, and residents will be able to come and go, the bridge will be completely closed for several months.

We will hold weekly on-site meetings open to the public on Tuesdays at 10:30 a.m. These meetings are an excellent opportunity to learn about the week ahead in construction and possible impacts. These meetings begin on May 14 and will initially be located near the intersection of Old Midway Road and Hermantown Road.
